**Purpose:** To allow those planning or conducting research and restoration pertinent to Garry oak ecosystems to make a brief presentation of their study/ies; to prompt discussion and encourage coordination among agencies; and to facilitate research and its application to the conservation of Garry oak and associated ecosystems.

**Format:** Presentations are 10-15 minutes each, followed by a brief question period. Presentation abstracts will be compiled into a Proceedings document, to be distributed (via email only) following the Colloquium. Note that persons unable to attend may also submit an abstract for inclusion in the Proceedings.

**Presenters:** Those wishing to present are required to register by **Friday, January 21<sup>st</sup>**. An abstract (approx. 500 words) will need to be submitted for inclusion in the Proceedings. Please indicate any preference for speaking time (i.e. morning or afternoon) in your registration. A digital projector will be provided and presenters requiring any additional audio-visual support should specify; slide projector, overhead projector and flip chart are also available upon request. Please send any digital presentations to Kathryn Martell ([kathryn.martell@goert.ca](mailto:kathryn.martell@goert.ca)) by **Friday, February 4<sup>th</sup>** to allow for advance testing. Some travel support is available for student presenters registered in a British Columbia institution.

**Registration:** Attendance is free, although pre-registration is required to assist in our planning for the day.
